This official government site provides authoritative information on Medicare. Useful features: The Medicare Plan Choices describes retiree health insurance options, including those that combine Medicare with private “Medigap” insurance.

This site focuses on housing and lifestyle choices for retirees. It contains information about retirement communities, state property and sales taxes. Useful features: Compares the income, sales and property taxes retirees might encounter in each state, and notes tax exemptions granted to seniors. Has additional links for other resources that can be helpful for senior living.
